
The heart and soul of Judo, in the opinion of the Australian Kodokan Judo Association, is in mainstream grassroots judo clubs across the country who cater to juniors, young adults, senior players and veterans who support and applaud the sporting and competitive facets of judo but do it themselves as a complete personal development system possibly for the whole of their lives, not just as young Olympic hopefuls or elite athletes. To this end, the AKJA's resources are devoted to the development of judo in its entirety, with no special emphasis on the elite or the political desirability of developing international competitors.

This year The Australian Kodokan Judo Association national championships are being held early in October in Melbourne, facilitated by the **Victorian Amateur Judo Union**. The history of the V.A.J.U. began in 1952 in Brunswick, Victoria and the V.A.J.U. was a foundation member of the J.F.A. The V.A.J.U. was instrumental in getting Judo recognized by the Australian Olympic Federation. In 1981 the V.A.J.U. organized the formation of the Australian Kodokan Judo Association (A.K.J.A.), which expanded very rapidly into all States of Australia and has conducted a National Judo championship annually ever since, plus sundry international events. To commemorate the national championships the V.A.J.U. are running a fundraiser so they can continue their good work in promoting the safe and fun pursuit of Kodokan Judo in Victoria.
